Ann Arbor, Michigan -- Based on the contractor's schedule for the Ann Arbor Bridges Replacement Project, the following action items will be taking place on **Tuesday, November 8, 2011**:

- Installation will begin for Temporary Traffic Control Devices and Signs around the project site and construction areas throughout the City. The signs will not be visible to the public, but they will be in the process of being installed.
- Contractor Mobilizes Equipment to the Project Site.
- Rose Street Permanently Closes between South State Street and White Street.
- White Street Permanently Closes from East Stadium Boulevard to Rose Street . White Street will be open, however motorists will not be able to access East Stadium Boulevard from White Street.
- These closures will mean **No Access** for vehicular traffic to White Street from East Stadium Boulevard. There will be no detour route for these closures. As part of the construction plan, these sections of Rose Street and White Street will be permanently closed.
- Sanitary Sewer Work along Rose Street begins. This work will not interrupt traffic on South State Street or East Stadium Boulevard.

Beginning the Week of November 14, 2011, the Contractor will begin Tree Clearing Operations in the Red Lot and Rose Street areas.
